The quarry also aided the flood victims on Berw Road and Sion Street through donation of cleaning products and other requested items, and the hire of a road sweeper to clean fronts of homes and gardens as well as public footpaths and pavements. This year the quarry also re-surfaced the access road to Maesycoed allotments in Pontypridd.

The stone quarried at Craig-Yr-Hesg provides vital building materials for road surfacing to local and national infrastructure projects. This high grade 68psv Gritstone is scarcely available elsewhere within the UK and hence is of national importance, both within Wales and the wider UK, something of which Rhondda Cynon Taff and the Welsh people should be proud of.

I have been closely involved with the management of CYH on and off since 2012 and understand the real human impact the closure of the site will have on my friends and colleagues who work at the site and the wider team in Hanson South Wales. In addition, the contractors employed on site are predominantly based in South Wales and dependant on the size of the company will be affected to a greater or lesser extent.

The site has engaged with the local community wherever possible and was instrumental in funding the construction of the new community centre in Glyncoch. We have sponsored local sports teams, offered practical assistance to the people in the houses on both sides of the river when the Taff flooded. Recently we surfaced the access road to an Allotments.

We tried to establish a liaison group with the local community, but this was rejected. However, we did continue to reach out and listen. Following feedback from the local community we proactively sought approval for and moved the access road to the site to a position which made it safer for all road users on Berw Road at a cost of over a million pounds showing that we do listen to the community and take appropriate action.

Environmental controls are constantly reviewed assessed and improved examples of these include: -

- Additional spray bars and curtain on the primary crusher dump hopper
- Introduction of a misting system inside operational buildings to contain fugitive dust
- Introduction of a dust foam system to mitigate dust
- Introduced electronic detonators and completed an assessment of the best delay sequence to ensure blast vibrations were mitigated as far as reasonably practicable

The stone we quarry is predominantly used in the surface layer of A-roads and motorways across Wales and further afield. The high PSV anti-skid material improves safety for every motorist and has undoubtedly saved many lives and prevented many accidents. It has also been used in the Welsh

Memorial in Flanders. Our stone is a nationally important construction material which is valuable to society.
